

## English

**Comprehension** - A range of fiction and non-fiction texts based on animals and humans. Class novel: Demon Dentist by David Walliams.

**Composition** - A range of narrative and non-narrative writing such as instructions, explanation writing, flowcharts and persuasive writing (creating a poster/leaflet.)
