

### English

Comprehension: A range of tasks based on fiction and non-fiction texts linked to animals including humans. Class novel 'Demon Dentist' by David Walliams. Text 'Pandoras Box'.

Composition: Links to class topic and myths and legends (art project). - narrative and non-narrative writing, – instructions of the digestive system, character descriptions, create their own play script.

Speaking and listening: Drama of parts of the class novel, freeze-frame, hot seating. Discussions of animals including humans.

### Science
