

### Literacy

We will continue with Sounds Write Unit to improve our Phonics. We are moving on to consonant clusters; sh,ch,ng,th. We are consolidating our single letter sound knowledge to read longer words. We will once again focus on learning our common exception words this term. We will be learning about **Pirates, Unicorns and Fairies**. We will be focusing on key texts to support our topic including 'Pirates in the Supermarket' and '**Peter Pan**'. We will use our independent writing skills to write to the fairies in Nursery Garden.

### Expressive Arts & Design

Learning sea shanties and pirate songs. **Making pirate hats, telescopes and hooks. Making Peter Pan hats, Fairy Dust and shadows. Performing a play based on 'Peter Pan'.**

### Personal, Social & Emotional Development

Playing games together, taking turns and sharing our things. Taking more responsibility for our classroom, working together on class projects and having 'jobs' in the classroom. Ensure that we treat our resources properly and all help at tidy up time. Having confidence to perform songs and our '**Peter Pan**' play.

### Maths

Focusing on number knowledge and counting on and back to 100. Look at Time and measuring weight and length. Using Money and looking at data handling and 3D shape. Developing our problem solving and reasoning skills. These will be linked to our topic theme.

### Knowledge of the World

A focus on **treasure maps** and map skills. How do Pirates find their way? Looking at compasses and **telescopes**. Learning about the creatures under the sea that Pirates may encounter! Learning about garden plants and flowers in relation to the school **Fairy Garden**.

### RE
