

English – This term we will be using the book **'You wouldn't want to be on Shackleton's Polar Expedition!' and 'The Secret Garden.'** We will be looking at non-fiction and classic texts. Our class novel will be The Borrowers.

Computing- Continuing to work on digital safety, using Powerpoint, Excel, Word and Scratch.

Science – Where does electricity come from? This term the topic will be Electricity and circuits and safety with electricity.

Art – Can I use a map to create art? We will be using maps to create art, looking at how artists have used maps to create artwork, for example, the map of the Tube in London. We will be linking to geography and mapping some of the streets of the village.

Maths – This term we are focussing on **Geometry – angles, shape, measure.** We will also be continuing to practise tables and the four operations in arithmetic.

Geography – What are the key human geographical features in our local area? We will be conducting some fieldwork in Cockfield, using aerial photographs, graphs, maps and conducting surveys. We will be considering if you really need a car to live in Cockfield, and looking at how well the village is served by shops, services and public transport.
