Halloween

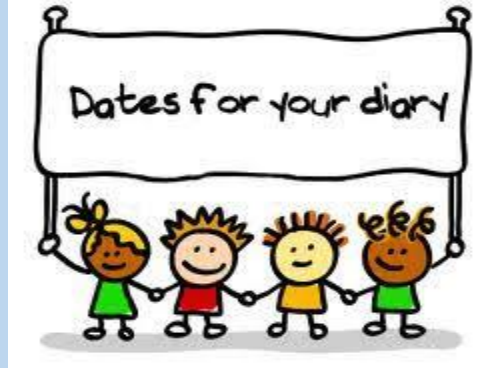
