


Results of Parent Questionnaire June 2021



Headteacher's Response

The governors would like to thank all of the parents and carers who took the time to respond to the questionnaire. We are delighted that the outcomes are so positive. Twenty-eight parents completed the questionnaire and of the parents who shared an opinion, 97% said that they would recommend the school to other parents, 100% agreed that their child does well at the school, 97% said that their child was happy and 100% said that their child feels safe.

We are pleased with the responses given in the questionnaires and are working hard to improve all areas of school especially those where parents would like to see particular improvements - the key one being keeping you informed about what your child is learning and how they are doing in school.

Our website is currently being redesigned and we are hoping that it will be more user friendly moving forward. From September we will be updating the school website each half term with the topic based "Big Questions" for each class and the knowledge organisers for each subject covered. Please remember to visit the website to look at the class pages in September and throughout the year – all this information will enable parents to find out what the children are learning and help you support your child.

We will also be resuming the termly progress reports which come home at the end of each term and hopefully we'll be able to invite parents into school more often to share in the children's learning in the usual way. COVID has made this difficult but as restrictions lift this will become a priority as parental partnership is vital to make sure we are doing our best for the children.

The newsletter will be published fortnightly on the school website and we will continue to use the text message service to keep parents informed. Unfortunately, we will not be resuming paper newsletters as we are trying to be more environmentally friendly in school and are restricting the amount of paper we send home.
