Our Response

The governors would like to thank all of the parents and carers who took the time to respond to the questionnaire. We are delighted that the outcomes are so positive. Twenty-four parents completed the questionnaire and of the parents who shared an opinion, 100% said that their child was happy at our school and 96% said they would recommend the school to other parents, 96% agreed that their child does well and 96% said that their child feels safe.

We are pleased with the responses given in the questionnaires and are working hard to improve all areas of school especially those where parents would like to see particular improvements. I am really pleased that 92% of parents said that they felt better informed as this was a key area for improvement last year and we have worked hard on this, introducing Clasdojo, fortnightly newsletters and improving our website and social media presence.

Although our records and all external visitors comment on how wonderfully behaved our children are and on the excellent climate for learning, we have had a small increase in the number of children who struggle to meet our high expectations and have therefore done some work on this. We have recently updated our behaviour policy and introduced a clearer system of rewards and sanctions in class to ensure a consistent approach.

This year we have also enrolled in the BIG Award for Bullying Intervention which will give us an opportunity to further strengthen our work in this area and hopefully to involve the children and parents more in this area. We will need your help and support with this moving forward.
